(All verses NKJV except where noted)

Psalm 145:3, 5-6

Great *is* the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness *is* unsearchable.

Psalm 145: 5-6

I will meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty, and on Your wondrous works. *Men* shall speak of the might of Your awesome acts, and I will declare Your greatness.

Ephesians 3:20-21

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Jeremiah 32:17

Exodus 15:11
