

Society was affecting the beliefs the believers and discouraging them their walk with and work for the Lord.






1. Don't You Get Off Course Steadfast Be Settled – Be Firm




Don't Let Someone Else Get Off Cour Immovable Unmovable – Not moved from its place




3. Don't Stop Always At All Times

4. Don't Forget Knowing Perceive Properly




5. Do Activity for the Kingdom Work Activity which brings physical weariness and fatigue
