Cannot be pleased...we often create a god that's absent. This is deism.


At least believers in a Santa Claus god can laugh and sing

At least the child abuser god solicits some kind of action


Sadly, believers in the deist idol. do nothing.




If the bad stuff in life comes from a monster Father, I will continue to seethe with anger.

Don't expect freedom to come without a truggle. Until a Christian struggles with the issue cedom, he or she will remain frightened, obsessive and bound.



Someone once said, simplicity on this side of complexity is worthless, but simplicity on the other side of complexity is worth whatever you have to pay to get there.








A multitude of intellectual and rational justifications support the premise that a good God remains in charge of the mess


