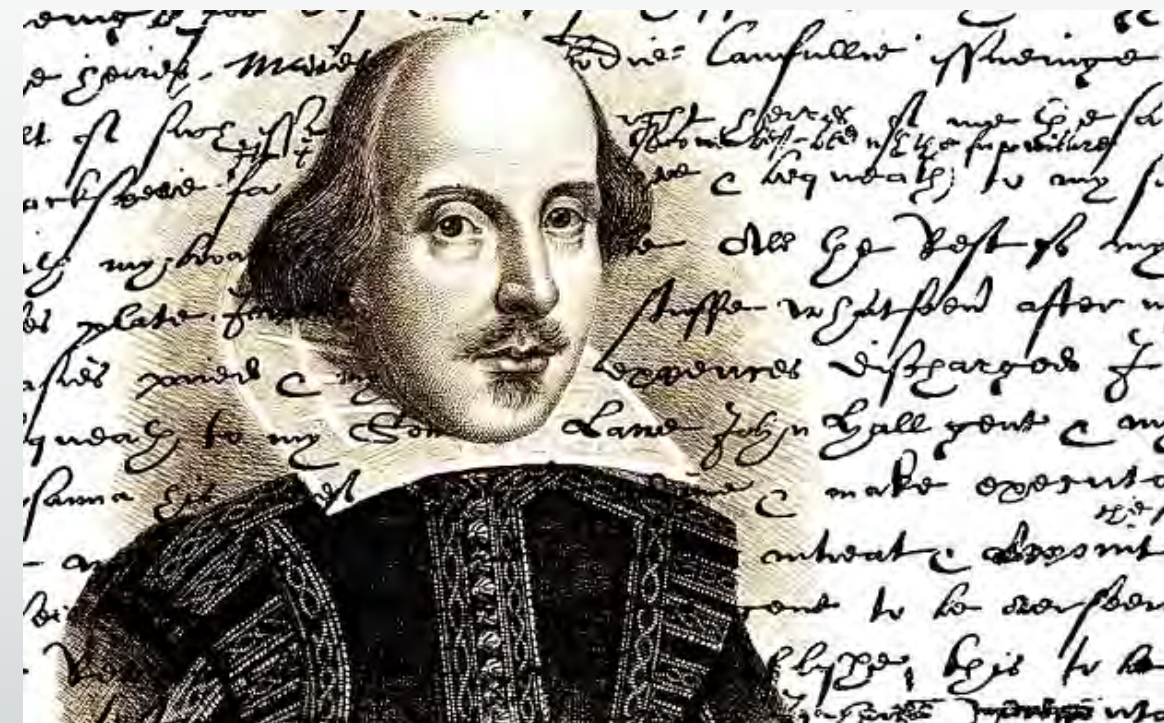

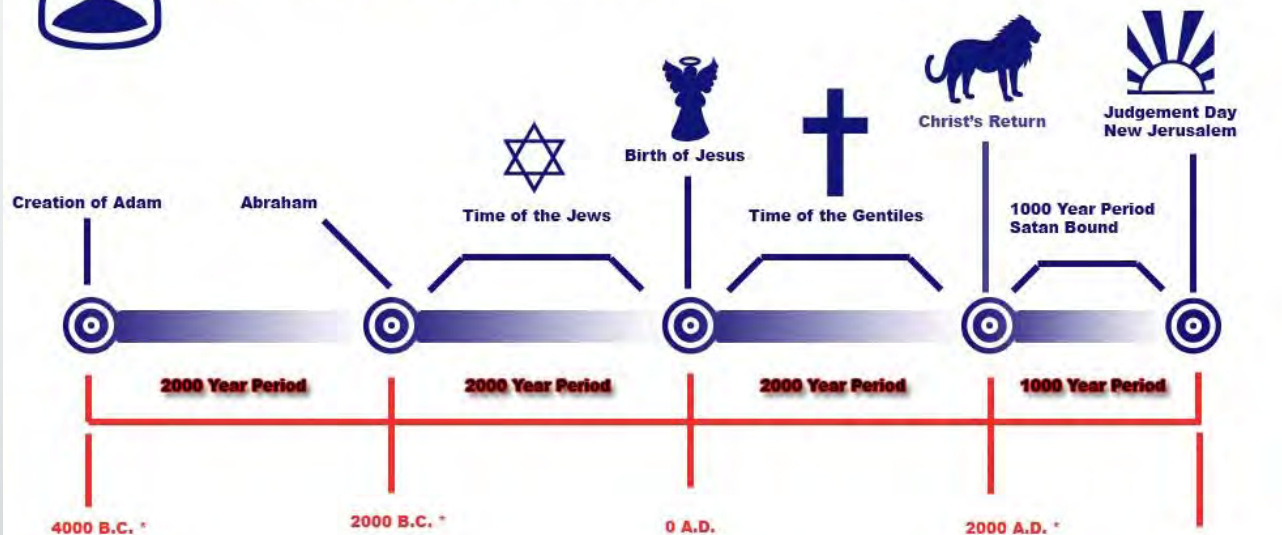

In the beginning God created
the heavens and the earth.
Genesis 1:1

God (Elohim) is transcendent

He is distinct from His creation.

He is not a rock, mountain, tree, river,
or animal. He is beyond time, space,
and matter.

Everyone who ever created anything
among men used matter that existed.
God created matter from nothing.

Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good; and God divided the light from the darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day.

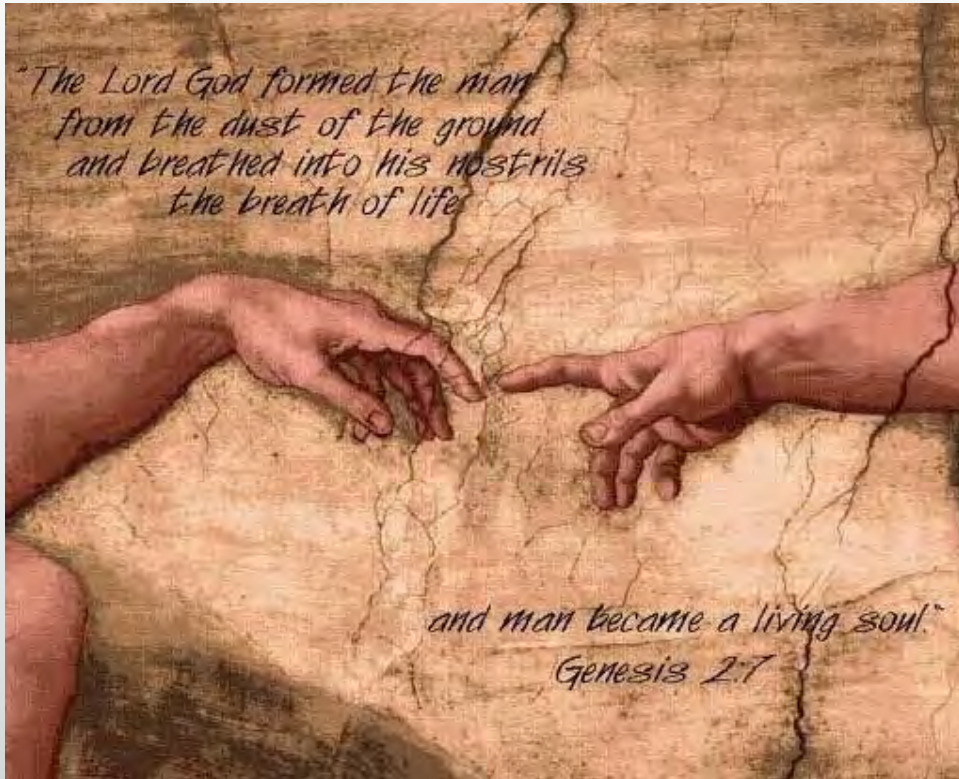



YAHWEH-JIREH

“The Lord our provider”

This is also the name Abraham gave to the place where the Lord provided a sacrifice in place of Isaac. (Gen. 22:14).

YAHWEH-NISSI

“Our banner, a banner of love and protection”

Also the name Moses gave to the altar he built after defeating the Amalekites (Ex. 17:15).

YAHWEH-SHALOM

“Our perfect peace”

Also the name Gideon gave to the altar he built at Ophrah (Judges 6:24)



YAHWEH-SABAOTH

“The Lord of Hosts, our Protector.”

The Lord rules the angels, the stars, the elements, and all the hosts of Heaven; and the Heaven of heavens is under His sway

YAHWEH-RAAH

“Our Shepherd”

He tenderly leads us, loves us and will keep us safe.”
