

People often get discouraged and upset at how God blesses others, because of their giving, and not them.




Why did God accept one offering and reject the other offering?

Hebrews 11:4

By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks.


So let each one give as he purposes in his heart,
