Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.








Honoring God With Our Money



#### Genesis 14 – Abram Rescues Lot


Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High. Genesis 14:18




And he blessed him and said:

Now the king of Sodom said to Abram, "Give me the persons, and take the goods for yourself."




#### Hebrews 7 – Priest after the Order of Melchizedek

#### Hebrews 7 – Priest after the Order of Melchizedek







