
Result of Deception

They spoke against Israel vs. 12

They joined in attacking Israel vs. 13

They robbed Israel vs. 13

Divine Judgment on Edom

Reasons for this Judgment vs 10-14

They cut off Israel's escape route vs. 14

They gave Israel escapees to captives vs. 14

Divine Blessing on Israel vs. 17-21

Israel will survive vs. 17-18

Israel shall inherit the land vs. 19-20

The Kingdom will be the Lord's vs. 21

Joined in attack – Robbed – Handed them over


Galatians 6:7-10
